Order re: Pre-Appearance Release by the Hennepin County Sheriff Public Safety Facility Staff

---

This Order applies only to the Section II of the June 18, 2024, Standing Order issued by the undersigned. That Standing Order will be amended in the near future. This Order is intended to revert misdemeanor domestic offenses to the 2019 Standing Order provisions, put gross misdemeanor domestics in that same position, and clarify no contact orders will issue upon release until future amendment.

Effective immediately:

Sections II.C.2 and II.D.2 of the June 18, 2024, Standing Order of the same name as this Order are rescinded.

Tab charged/Citations for Domestic Abuse offenses when a person is arrested without a warrant and is going to be charged by the arresting officer, a citation or tab charge shall be issued and the accused released unless continued detention is necessary as provided in Minn. R. Crim. P. 6.01. A person detained pursuant to Minn. R. Crim. P. 6.01 shall be held without bail (HWB), and brought to the next available session of court, unless the person is ordered released earlier by a judge or the Department of Community Corrections and Rehabilitation (DOCCR) pursuant to the standards set by separate Standing Order.

Any person released by judicial order or by DOCCR who was being held related to a domestic offense shall be ordered to have no contact with the alleged victim named in the police report. Such order for no contact shall be made by a Conditional Release Order stamped with the Criminal Presiding or Chief Judge's signature.
