Overview Purpose

MyMNConservator (MMC) is an online application launched in 2014 to allow conservators to file their inventory and annual accountings electronically. The Minnesota Judicial Branch continues to improve its applications in keeping with its vision to be responsive to the general public's needs. This overview will document updates moving forward.

Release Details

August 7, 2024

Development was done as part of Advancement of MN Vulnerable Adult Care project. The project is funded by a grant from the Administration For Community Living, a division of the federal Department of Health and Human Services.

MMC Landing Page

The page displayed when arriving to the MMC website was streamlined to focus more clearly on notifications.

Conservator Profile

- Fields were rearranged to make it clearer what conservators need to do to set up emailed notifications.
- A section was added so that conservators can opt into text message notifications to remind them about reports.

Conservator Dashboard

- Text was added on the Person Subject to Conservatorship page to make it clear to
 conservators that the name of the person subject to conservatorship should be selected
 to see a history of reports.
- Reports sorted in a more logical order so that reports will appear in the order they were submitted.
- The **Reports to Work On** tab was renamed (from simple **Reports**) so that conservators have an easy way to see which reports are coming up upon their due dates.

• Income & Expense Transactions

Fields were rearranged so that the questions asked about transactions flow more logically. First asking the conservator what type of transaction needs to be entered (i.e., income, expense, transfer) before asking for details (date, description, and amount).

• Emergency Conservator Reports

- MMC will automatically calculate and reflect the correct report start/end date periods
 for the annual report when the first-year accounting includes the emergency reporting
 period (i.e., over what time period am I expected account for transactions that affected
 the assets owned by the person subject to the conservatorship).
- MMC will automatically determine whether an emergency conservator is expected to submit a Final Account report if different individuals were appointed as general conservators, and the emergency appointment has ended.

Digital Accessibility

- MMC updated to comply with WCAG 2.1 (Level A and AA) standards.
