Multiple Guardians

In cases where the court has appointed more than one guardian, each co-guardian is responsible for completing and filing an annual Personal Well-Being Report in MyMNGuardian (MMG). However, if co-guardians agree with all of the statements in a single report, they can use MMG's co-signing process to have multiple guardians sign a single report.


Co-Signing Process

Follow the steps in the <u>Filing the Personal Well-Being Report and Affidavit of Service</u> guide with special attention to the following steps.

Starting the report

The Add Co-Signers dialogue box will appear after confirming the correct case information and reporting period.


- 1. Select the check box next to the name of the co-guardians who wish to co-sign the report.
- 2. Select Continue.




Signing the Report

The Sign and Submit dialogue box will appear after you have reviewed and confirmed you would like to Submit Report.

- 1. On the Sign tab, the guardian filling out the report will type their name to sign the report.
- 2. Select Continue.



- 3. On the **Co-Guardian** tab, select **Yes** to confirm the co-guardian agrees with all comments of the report.
- 4. The co-guardian will type their name to sign the report.
- 5. Select Next.



- If you select **No**, the signature box will not appear, but you can still select **Next**. However, the co-guardian will need to submit their own report.
- 6. On the **Submit** tab, read the submission statement, then select **Submit Report**.
