Mediation and Restorative Services (MARS) is no costs conflict resolution service that will assist tenants and homeowners facing eviction, lease termination, move-out plans, security deposits, unpaid rent, repairs and maintenance or other landlord-tenant topics. MARS help all parties avoid the cost and time commitment of going to court and resolve these important issues directly.

If you cannot contact a legal or mediation service provider before your hearing, attorneys and mediators may be available to assist on the day of your hearing virtually/via phone. Services begin at 8:30 a.m. Clients are helped on a first-come, first-serve basis.
