There will be attorneys available for one-on-one consultations. Each appointment will be approximately 30 minutes either by Zoom or by phone. There are no income eligibility requirements- the clinics are free to all. If you do not have a device to use Zoom, check with your local law library as tablets may be available.

Family Law Clinic
